Thin-film (CIGS) is the lightest and most flexible but has the lowest efficiency (13-18%). This guide compares all three technologies for portable and off-grid solar use. Thin-film solar panels use a 2nd generation technology varying from the crystalline silicon (c-Si) modules, which is the most popular technology. Thin-film solar cells (TFSC) are manufactured using a single or multiple layers of PV elements over a surface comprised of a variety of glass, plastic. Often no thicker than a piece of paper, thin-film solar panels are among the least visible advancements in renewable energy technology today. Unlike traditional silicon panels, which are rigid and bulky, thin-film panels are lightweight, flexible and easier to install on a wider range of surfaces.
