The EBRD has launched a tender to build three solar plants totaling 28 MW in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Interested developers must submit offers by May 26. Bosnia and Herzegovina has huge photovoltaic power potential. However, in the absence of a clear regulatory framework, there is a risk that big investors will build solar power plants, putting profit before the environment and sustainability. Thanks to its climate, Bosnia and Herzegovina has. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) plans to provide €50 million in financing to support the development, construction, and operation of eight new solar power plants across the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (FBiH).
