Overview

Grid-connected inverters are power electronic devices that convert direct current (DC) power generated by renewable energy sources, such as solar panels or wind turbines, into alternating current (AC) power that can be fed into the electrical grid or used locally. However, a grid tie system can take the conversion one step further. While solar inverters are the most common type of inverter used for residential solar, they are just one of several inverter. There is a rapid increase in the amount of inverter-based resources (IBRs) on the grid from Solar PV, Wind, and Batteries. All of these technologies are Inverter-based Resources (IBRs).
