Overview

While solar energy dates back centuries, Apollo fast-tracked its efficiency. This spurred advancements in photovoltaic efficiency, with post-Apollo technologies achieving up to 20% efficiency. Space stations use photovoltaic cells for their high power-to-weight ratio. The longest mission duration accomplished with a fuel cell seems to be a few weeks: Gemini 7 (13 days 8:35:01), Apollo 17 (12 days 13:51:59) and STS-80 (17 days, 15:53). (Soyuz 7K-LOK would have used fuel cells for its moon.
