Overview

Approved by the bank's Board of Executive Directors, the project entails the development of 30 MW of solar parks with battery energy storage systems as well as the enhancement of transmission grid infrastructure in the country. The project will be implemented until June 2030. From reducing energy costs to ensuring power reliability, solar storage systems offer transformative potential for Guinea-Bissau. The project will (i) introduce the first-of-its-kind near-shore marine floating solar photovoltaic. In a landmark deal signaling robust growth, Apus Energy, the Dubai-based energy conglomerate, has entered into a formidable drilling contract for Diamond Offshore's state-of-the-art Ocean BlackRhino drillship to tap into a promising exploration well off the coast of Guinea-Bissau. This agreement. The Ministry of Energy of Guinea-Bissau, with the support of the ECOWAS Commission through the Regional Off-Grid Access to Electricity Project (ROGEAP), officially launched the mission to develop the country's first National Energy Policy on Wednesday, 23rd of July 2025, in Bissau.
