

New farmer solar power generation



Overview

Farmers can benefit from solar energy in several ways-by leasing farmland for solar; installing a solar system on a house, barn, or other building; or through agrivoltaics. According to a recent U. Department of Energy report, Solar Futures Study, "it is now possible to envision-and chart a path toward-a future where solar provides 40% of the nation's electricity by 2035. " In that future, farmers and farmland will play a key role. Agrivoltaics is defined as agriculture, such as crop production, livestock grazing, and pollinator habitat, located underneath. Solar energy systems convert the sun's rays into usable AC power for your home or business. The panels help make this possible by creating direct current (DC) that an inverter then converts into alternating current (AC) for use in the home. Energy produced goes directly to the home's electrical. It is NOT 'bad' to use the new keyword. But if you forget it, you will be calling the object constructor as a regular function. If your constructor doesn't check its execution context then it won't notice that 'this'



When to use "new" and when not to, in C++?

You should use new when you wish an object to remain in existence until you delete it. If you do not use new then the object will be destroyed when it goes out of scope.
