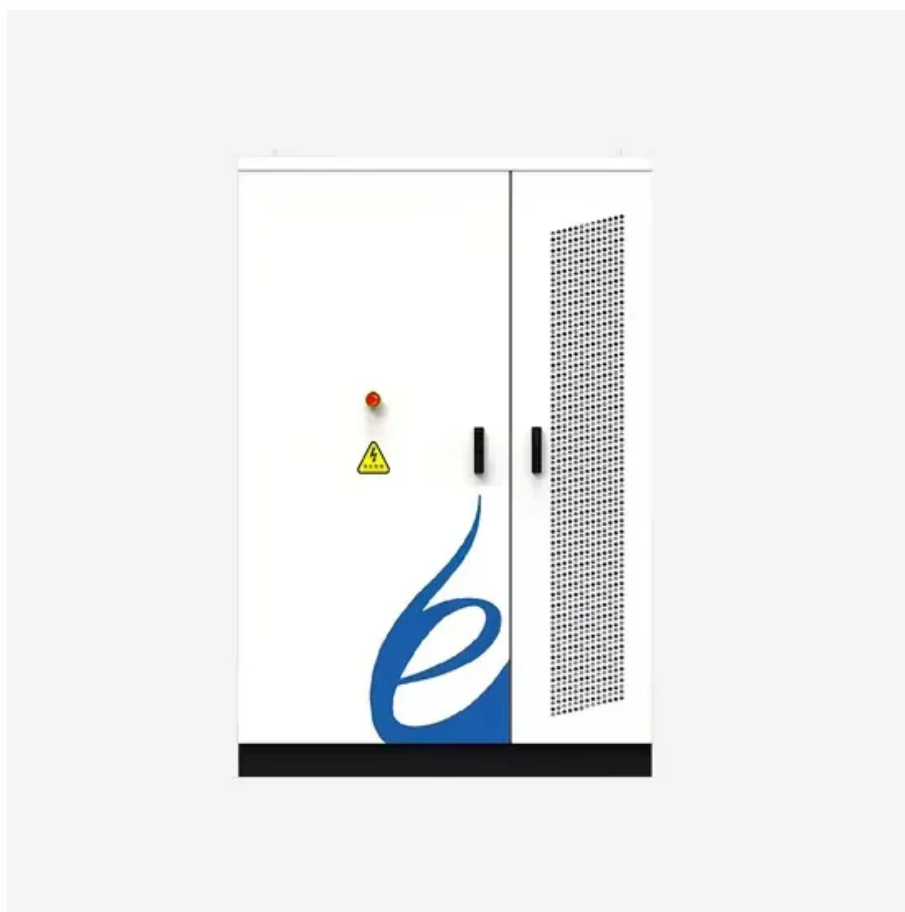


# One photovoltaic panel per inverter
