Effective from November 1, 2025, until December 31, 2027, a 50% VAT refund will be applied to the sales of electricity produced from offshore wind power. This measure is aimed at supporting the sector's continued development. The policy also outlines VAT rules for nuclear power.

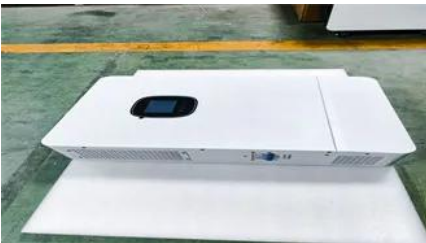
